Jeffrey has a wide range of non-profit management experience including working on the Fulbright Scholars Program, starting a Health Equity team at the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, and running professional development programs at OCA - Asian Pacific American Advocates. He received his Masters in Public Administration from Baruch College through the National Urban Fellows program and his Bachelor degree from the University of Southern California.
