JAPANESE AMERICAN LEADERSHIP DELEGATION PROGRAM - THIS PROGRAM PROVIDES THE OPPORTUNITY FOR JAPANESE AMERICAN LEADERS FROM THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES TO TRAVEL TO JAPAN AT THE INVITATION OF THE JAPANESE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS. THE USJC ADMINISTERS THE PROGRAM ANNUALLY. THE PROGRAM BEGAN IN 2000 AND CREATES THE OPPORTUNITY FOR JAPANESE AMERICAN LEADERS TO BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH JAPANESE LEADERS IN THE GOVERNMENT, BUSINESS, POLITICAL, NON-PROFIT AND EDUCATIONAL SECTORS. THE PROGRAM ALSO PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY FOR JAPANESE LEADERS TO GAIN A GREATER UNDERSTANDING ABOUT MULTI-CULTURAL AMERICA THROUGH THE EXPERIENCES OF A DIVERSE GROUP OF JAPANESE AMERICANS. UPON THEIR RETURN FROM THIS ONE WEEK TRIP, DELEGATES WORK WITH PROGRAM ALUMNI, LOCAL JAPANESE CONSULATES, AND THE USJC TO IMPLEMENT PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES TO FURTHER BUILD REGIONAL U.S.-JAPAN RELATIONS. THERE WERE 10 MEMBERS OF THE 2013 PROGRAM AND TO DATE 173 HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE PROGRAM.
