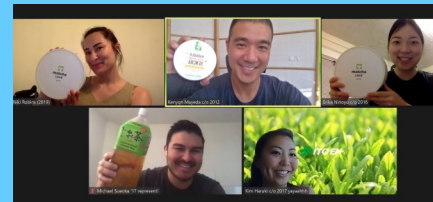
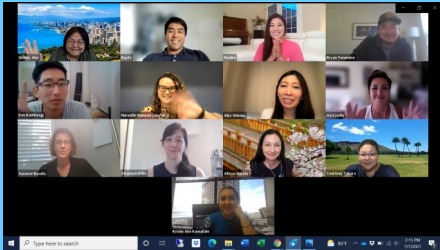


2021 EMERGING LEADERS PROGRAM
