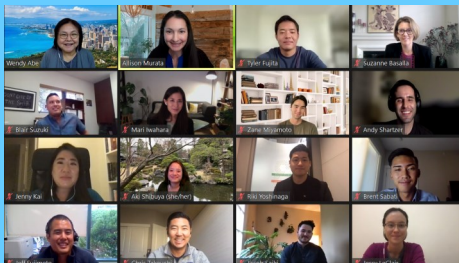
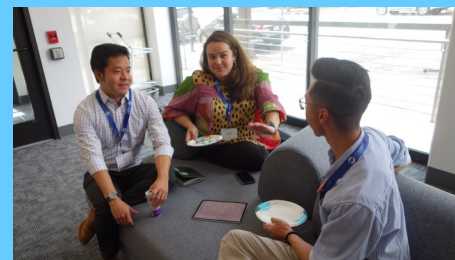




2022 EMERGING LEADERS PROGRAM
